1. Installation and Registration

1.1 Installation

If the ADnota album is already installed on your MMC, you can skip this section and proceed with registration.

ADnota album is delivered in a device software installation file named Adnota_album_V4_xx.sis.

Note: Please make sure that you download the proper file for your type of phone.

To install ADnota album proceed as follows:

- If an older version of ADnota album is installed on your phone, use the *Remove* function in the *Application manager* to uninstall it.
- Establish a connection between your mobile phone and your PC via USB, infrared or Bluetooth. If you have installed the Nokia PC Suite for your phone on your PC:

Select *Install Applications*. Search for the file in the *my Computer* and start the installation by double clicking the file. Follow the installation instructions.

Otherwise:

Manually transfer the file to your phone via Bluetooth, USB or infrared connection.

- When the file transfer is completed, you will find a new message in **Menu**→*Messaging*→*Inbox*.
- Open the message to start installing and follow the installation prompts.

Note: You may install ADnota album in the Phone memory (D:) or in the Memory card (E:). In either case the database will be located in the Memory card.

After a successful installation you will find an icon named "album" in **Menu**→*Applications*.

For further information on installing software, please refer to the operating instructions of your device.

Tip: To save space on your phone, you may delete the message containing the installation file from the messaging inbox after the installation.

To install ADnota album on another MMC or to install a new version of ADnota album, download the installation file from

www.adnota.com/en/downloads.html and proceed as described above. Your registration key remains valid. To copy the database, copy all files and subdirectories in *E:\pictures* and in *E:\adpic* to your PC, change the MMC and copy those directories and files to the new MMC.

1.2 Registration

To get your key, purchase ADnota album from your software shop. After the purchase, the registration key is delivered via e-mail. Enter the key in the *Registration* dialogue.

Note: If ADnota album is already installed on your MMC, you don't have to reinstall it.

1.3 Remove ADnota album

To remove ADnota album, use the *Application Manager* in your phone. The *Application Manager* will not delete the database nor the pictures generated by ADnota album. To remove the database, delete the files and subdirectories in *E:\adpic*. To delete the pictures, use the ADnota album Delete function before removing the ADnota album, or use the *Gallery*.

2. Overview Screen

This section describes the actions available in the overview screen.

2.1 Manage Pictures

Open Pictures

1 Scroll to the picture

Note: Fast scrolling: press (#) to move forward one screen, or press (*) to move backward one screen.

2 Press the navigation key or select **Options**→*Open*.

Information lines

The overview screen displays two lines of status information; one above the thumbnails and one below.

In the upper line, the first number indicates the index of the picture the cursor points to. Next is the total number of pictures. If GPS is available and connected, the distance between your current position and the picture the cursor points to is indicated at the end of this line.

The bottom line indicates the status of the GPS connection. If GPS is available and connected, this line shows your current coordinates. If GPS is connected and the receiver has not synchronized to the GPS signal, the line displays “GPS ready”.

Search for Pictures

- Select **Options**→*Search*→*Voice, Text, Date, Location*. The results are displayed in a relevance sorted overview with the top matches in the top left corner. A vertical red bar on the right side of the thumbnail indicates the closeness of the match.

Note: The list of results is limited to the 100 best matches.

- If you select **Options**→*Search*→*Voice* or shortcut ②, the search returns *all pictures with voice tags*, sorted by their similarity to the query.

- After the voice recording starts, speak the search word. Search starts when the recording time has elapsed (the red progress bar has reached the end).

Note: Voice search can only find pictures associated with voice tags (keywords).

Note: A voice search may return pictures that do not contain your query as a voice tag. As voice search can never be fail-safe, it is preferable to include acoustically close matching results than to miss possible matches.

- If you select **Options**→*Search*→*Text*, the search returns all images whose names match or contain the search string.

- 1 Enter the text in the pop-up text box

- 2 and press **OK**.

- If you select **Options**→*Search*→*Date*→*To*, the search returns all pictures taken up to the specified date.

- 1 Enter the date in the pop-up date field

- 2 and press **OK**.

- If you select **Options**→*Search*→*Date*→*From*, the search returns all pictures taken since the specified date.

- 1 Enter the date in the pop-up date field

- 2 and press **OK**.

- If you select **Options**→*Search*→*Location*→*Current*, the search returns all pictures taken at or close to your current location. The resulting list will be ordered by the distance to your current position.

Note: If ADnota album is connected to a GPS receiver with sufficient reception, the search will be based primarily on the GPS data. Otherwise it will rely on the cell IDs of the network.

- If you select **Options**→*Search*→*Location*→*Of picture*, the search returns all pictures taken at the location or close to the location of the selected picture.

Note: Location based search can only find pictures taken with ADnota album or imported pictures tagged with GPS data in EXIF format.

- After viewing the results:

- To leave the results screen and return to the overview screen press **Back**.

Note: After the return the display shows the picture selected in the results screen in the original overview screen. This feature can be used to concatenate searches, e.g. execute a voice search to find a picture of a location, followed by *Search*→*Position*→*Of picture* to find more pictures of that location.

- To refine your search select **Options**→*Refine search*→*Voice, Text, Date, Location* and proceed as above. The refinement search is conducted on the previous search results only. The new result contains those items that match the current *and* the previous search criteria.

Information line

The information line above the thumbnails displays:

- First the ranking of the picture the cursor is pointing to,
- followed by the total number of pictures in the result list.
- If GPS is available and connected, the next figure is the distance from the picture the cursor is pointing to, either your current position (if the search command used the *Current* option) or the picture the search was started from (if the search command used the *Of picture* option).

Take Pictures

1 Select **Options**→*New picture* or press ①. The view finder now displays the view to be captured.

To adjust the settings of the camera, press the navigation key ← or → to the setting you want to change. Press the navigation key ↑ or ↓ to adjust the setting.

2 To take a picture, press the camera key, the scroll key or **OK**.

3 After capturing the picture:

- Save the picture by pressing **Back**, or
- Take a new picture by selecting **Options**→*Change picture* or press a navigation key (right or left)

Note: If ADnota album is connected to a GPS receiver and the receiver has synchronized to the incoming signal, the GPS coordinates will be included in the picture file.

Note: If you open the lens cover while ADnota album is running, the genuine camera application of the device is activated. To continue working with ADnota album, either close the camera application or change to ADnota album. To close the camera application, press the **Exit** key. To change the application, press the **Menu** key until the active applications are listed, then select ADnota album.

Note: ADnota album supports only the main camera.

Delete Pictures

1 Scroll to the picture and

2 select **Options**→*Delete* or press ©.

2.2 Settings and Administration

Change Settings

1 Select **Options**→*Settings*.

2 Scroll to the settings item you wish to change and press the scroll key to

- toggle between options if there are only two (e.g. high/low).
- open a list of options.
- open a slider view. Push the scroll key on the right or left to increase or decrease the value, respectively.

Grid size

This option sets the default size/number of thumbnails in the overview grid.

Volume

This slider changes the default volume when playing audio, e.g. voice tags.

Picture quality

Picture quality selects the quality the pictures are stored in. Low quality takes less memory space.

GPS settings

To change the GPS settings select **Options**→*Settings*. Use the navigation key to switch to the GPS tab.

Connect

This switch toggles the connection mode to the GPS receiver.

Position Format

This option selects the format in which the GPS data is displayed.

Connect to GPS

To use the integrated GPS receiver (if available) select main
Menu→*Tools*→*Settings*→*General*→*Positioning*→*Positioning methods*→*Integrated GPS*. Select **Options**→*Connect GPS* in the ADnota album main menu.

To connect an external Bluetooth GPS device, switch on the device. Set the positioning method to *Bluetooth GPS*:

Menu→*Tools*→*Settings*→*General*→*Positioning*→*Positioning methods*→*Bluetooth GPS*. Make sure that the Bluetooth receiver is enabled:

Menu→*Tools*→*Bluetooth*→*Bluetooth*→*On*.

1 Select **Options**→*Connect GPS*. The first time the phone starts to search for devices within range. Bluetooth enabled devices that are within range start to appear on the display one by one.

- To interrupt the search, press Stop. The device list freezes and you can start to form a connection to one of the devices already found.

2 Scroll to the device you want to connect with and press **Select**.

Note: This procedure is executed only the first time you connect to your GPS device. Your selection is stored in *Paired devices*. The next time you connect to a GPS receiver, your phone will use this device. If you want to change to an other receiver, you have to delete the selection in your phones *Paired devices*, and repeat the selection procedure described above. .

For further information on connecting to Bluetooth devices please refer to the operating instructions of your phone and GPS device.

For further information on positioning accuracy and reception please refer to the manual of your device.

Note: If you have selected the Automatic mode in the GPS settings, ADnota album automatically connects to your GPS receiver on start up.

Disconnect a GPS Device

- To disconnect a connected GPS device select **Options**→*Disconnect GPS*.

Import Pictures

At start up ADnota album searches through the image directories of the internal memory and the MMC for new pictures. Those are imported automatically. Pictures older than the latest entrance in ADnota album's database are not imported.

If you select **Options**→*Import pictures*, ADnota album searches through the image directories and their subdirectories, in the internal memory and in the MMC. All images that are not yet contained in the ADnota database are imported.

3. Picture View Screens

Once you have opened a picture the following actions are available.

3.1 View Pictures

Scroll

- To scroll within the picture, use the scroll key.

Zoom

- To zoom in, out or to original size, press **Options**→**Zoom**→then either
 - **Zoom in** or press ⑤, to zoom in, or
 - **Zoom out** or press ⑥ to zoom out, or
 - **100%**, to zoom to original size (one-to-one resolution).

Rotate

- To rotate the picture clockwise or anticlockwise, press **Options**→**Rotate**→then either
 - **Left** or press ①, to rotate anticlockwise, or
 - **Right** or press ②, to rotate clockwise.

Toggle Display Modes

ADnota album supports several display modes that may be freely combined.

- To toggle between normal and full screen mode, select **Options**→**Full screen** or press (*).
- To toggle between image viewing mode and detail mode select **Options**→**Details** or press (#).

3.2 Manipulate Picture Files

Add Keywords

- 1 Select **Options**→**Add keyword**, recording starts automatically after the tone.
- 2 Speak the keyword. Recording ends when the recording time has elapsed (the red progress bar has reached the end).

Replay Keywords

If you have added keywords to a picture you can replay them one after another by selecting **Options**→**Keywords**.

Delete Keywords

To delete keywords

- 1 select **Options**→**Keywords** to start replaying all keywords.
- 2 press **Delete** while the keyword you want to delete is replayed.

Rename Pictures

- 1 Select **Options**→**Rename**, a text box opens.
- 2 Enter the new name in the text box and
- 3 confirm by pressing **OK**.

Note: Renaming a picture does not change the name of the image file.

Save Changes

- To save any changes made to a picture press **Back**.

Send Pictures

- Select **Options**→**Send**→**Via multimedia, e-mail, Bluetooth, infrared**.
 - If you select **Options**→**Send**→**Via multimedia**, the picture is inserted into a new multimedia message. You may add other objects to the message and enter a text.
 - If you select **Options**→**Send**→**Via e-mail**, the picture will be attached to a new e-mail. You may add other objects to the e-mail and enter a text.
 - If you select **Options**→**Send**→**Via Bluetooth**, the picture will be transferred via Bluetooth to devices you choose.
 - If you select **Options**→**Send**→**Via infrared**, the picture will be transferred via infrared to the other device.

For further information on creating a multimedia message or an e-mail and on data transfer via Bluetooth and infrared, please refer to the manual of your device.

Note: The availability of certain messaging services and communications may be subject to provision by your network operator or service provider and/or presence of necessary settings. For further information, please refer to the manual of your device and contact your network operator or service provider.

4. Data Backup

To prevent loss of data, it is recommended to make regular backup copies of your data.

- To make a backup copy of your data, make a copy of the complete contents of your MMC memory card

or

- make a copy of the directory “[E:\ADPIC](#)” and “[E:\Pictures](#)” and all of its subdirectories.

For further information on backing up data please refer to the operating instructions of your device.

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
