Desktop

- Use the joystick on your Nokia 7650 phone to control the PC's mouse pointer
- Keys on the mobile phone keyboard can be mapped to the PC keyboard keys
- The user has to define key mapping in a configuration file for each PC application
- You can switch between configured applications with the Nokia 7650 phone display

Windows 98se, ME, 2000 with SP2 or XP operating system
Microsoft PowerPoint versions 95, 97, 2000 or 2002

Nokia 7650 phone

Nokia Wireless Presenter in a single executable file (1.8MB)

Special notes

The application is based on Bluetooth technology. The maximum range between the mobile phone and laptop is 10m. Physical barriers between the devices may reduce maximum working distance

The license key is delivered via email after purchase. The software must be registered after the 14-day evaluation period to continue usage.

Security

Bluetooth connection can be encrypted with Bluetooth security, users can be authorised with PIN-keys

Nokia Wireless Presenter on a PC can be closed to prevent remote usage
